But August is also the best time of year to schedule a relaxing respite before the busy fall season commences. We've compiled a list of both new and tried-and-true spots for a restorative overnight stay in Central Texas. From luxury safari-style tents and spa resorts to an inn inspired by a classic horror movie, here are more than a dozen places to get away without going too far out of town.

Camp Fimfo

Locations: New Braunfels and Waco

The Scoop: If you loved summer camp as a child, you'll have a blast at Camp
Fimfo. Boasting a new second location in Waco as well as its original spot on the
Guadalupe River, this resort is all about activity, whether it's showing off your
putting skills with a game of mini golf, barreling down its Schlitterbahn-esque
slides, playing pickleball, or making old-school arts and crafts.

Flophouze

Location: Round Top

The Scoop: At this funky-cool getaway, you can spend the night in one of six shipping containers that are retrofitted with architectural salvage (think countertops made with old bowling alley lanes and kitchen cabinet bases from a Brooklyn laboratory). A great place to enjoy the simple pleasures, Flophouze is an ideal spot for stargazing or roasting marshmallows at your own private fire pit.

Perfect For: Those who want to unplug—or, alternately, aspiring influencers: Its eye-catching pool-hot tub combo has a clear front that looks incredible in social media photos.

Location: North Central Austin

The Scoop: The height of luxury, this 10-acre urban oasis by Auberge Resorts features lush English gardens, an organic farm, and an art deco-inspired pool complete with 40 chaise lounges. Admire the ornate furnishings curated by celebrity designer Ken Fulk, and nab a reservation well in advance to dine at onsite Lutie's Garden Restaurant, helmed by husband-and-wife duo Bradley Nicholson and Susana Querejazu (Odd Duck, Barley Swine).

Locations: Wimberley and Dripping Springs

Location: Bastrop

The Scoop: Slasher fans, rejoice: This unique property served as the filming location of the gas station featured in *The Texas Chainsaw Massacre* and now features four quaint cabins equipped with eerie red walls. Step inside "We Slaughter Barbecue" to find a trove of movie posters, dolls, masks, and costumes from horror movies. While here, snap a pic at the macabre photo op inspired by the film, which features a bloody bucket sitting underneath meat hooks. Spooky!

Perfect For: Cinephiles



Thompson Austin

Location: Downtown Austin

Perfect For: Book lovers and introverts


